In honor of Black History Month, the first webinar will be on February 24, 2021 and feature Loretta Collins Argrett, a trailblazing attorney who has had a remarkable legal career. Among her many firsts, she was the first African American to serve as the Assistant Attorney General, Tax Division, in the United States Department of Justice and the first African American woman in Justice Department history to hold a position that required Senate confirmation.

This monthly series will spotlight different trailblazers and their paths to, and success in, the field of tax law. Future guests will include Samuel C. Thompson, Jr. (March 31, 2021) and Glenn Carrington (April 28, 2021).
