PRESS RELEASE

The United States Tax Court announced today that Chief Judge Kathleen Kerrigan has been re-elected and will serve another two-year term beginning June 1, 2024. Her current term as Chief Judge expires May 31, 2024.

The biennial election took place on February 16, 2024, in accordance with statutory requirements.

Chief Judge Kerrigan earned her B.S. from Boston College in 1985 and her J.D. from the University of Notre Dame Law School in 1990. After law school, she served as Legislative Director for Congressman Richard E. Neal. From 1998 to 2005, Judge Kerrigan was with Baker & Hostetler LLP in Washington, D.C., first as an Associate and then as a Partner. From 2005 until the time of her appointment to the Court by President Obama in 2012, Judge Kerrigan served as Tax Counsel for Senator John F. Kerry. Judge Kerrigan was first elected as Chief Judge for a two-year term effective June 1, 2022.
