Chief Judge Maurice B. Foley announced today that as of November 25, 2020, Senior Judge Robert P. Ruwe has fully retired and is no longer recalled for judicial service.

Judge Ruwe was appointed by President Ronald Reagan to serve as a judge of the United States Tax Court and assumed the office on November 20, 1987. He had served as a senior judge subject to recall since November 20, 2002. On April 27, 2012, Judge Ruwe received the J. Edgar Murdock Award for distinguished service to the United States Tax Court. The Court thanks Judge Ruwe for his many years of excellent service and contributions to the Court's jurisprudence.
