## **Change of Address:**

You must notify the Clerk of the Court if you change your address. See Rule 22(b)(4). If you filed your petition in paper, see Tax Court Form 10, Notice of Change of Address, under "Forms" on the Tax Court's Website at <u>www.ustaxcourt.gov</u>. If you filed your petition electronically, you may update your address under the "Case Information" tab in your case online. Failure to notify the Clerk of the Court of a change of your address can mean you do not receive notices and documents essential to your case and can lead to dismissal of your case.

## **Request for Remote Proceeding:**

You may request a remote (virtual) trial instead of an in-person trial. To do so, you must submit a Motion to Proceed Remotely. A form motion is available at <u>www.ustaxcourt.gov/case related forms.html</u>. If the Court grants your request, you will be provided with detailed instructions, including the date, time, and Zoomgov information for the remote proceeding.
